# Stix® Reporting

Stix® comes pre-programmed with many reports, such as those listed below. In most of these reports, you can select from a large number of reporting variables to generate many different reports from the same basic set-up. For example, you can run a report for one department only or for selected departments, include a detail or summary view that shows or summarizes individual entries, and select from over 25 reporting variables, depending on the type of report. The Injury & Illness Analysis report, for example, can be run by injury type, body part, work activity, and so on.

Whether standard reports or reports produced from the Wizard discussed below, all reports in Stix can be memorized for future use and batched for running as a group on a periodic basis. Just set up the batch to run for the dates you want, make sure your printer is full of paper, then go eat lunch while Stix creates your monthly (or other batch) reports.

The Stix Reporting Wizard enables you to select the fields from the database that you want for your report, and to specify their position on the report. You don’t have to be an IT expert to use the Wizard - you simply need to know what data you want to display on the report. The “memorize” feature enables you to save and re-run the individual reports that you’ve created. You can also combine these reports into batches to automatically run with the touch of a few keys.
